**SUBJECT:** Europe and Middle East on the way to a closer economical and political cooperation.

The speech by the representative of the Italian Government, Undersecretary for Infrastructure and Transports Mr. Bartolomeo Giachino, opened the conference organized by U.C.E.E. and E.C.T. - SHRIAN, whose aim is to transform the relationships among the European Community, and specifically Italy, with Gulf States and African States into an opportunity of bilateral economical development.

Dr. Andrea Giannetto, UCEE Managing Director, forward the support of Dr. Benoit NGOM, ADA (African Diplomatic Academy) President, and of Dr. Hassan S. Abou Al-Taher manager of H.R.H. Prince Bandar Bin Khalid Bin Abdul Aziz Al Saud.

Undersecretary Giachino has underlined the interest of the Italian Government to an ever closer relationship with non-EU countries, specifically with the countries represented at the meeting:

Saudi Arabia, U.A.E., Kuwait, Oman, Qatar, Djibouti and Ethiopia.

M.P.s Vito Bonsignore and Antonio Panzeri, from the European Parliament, confirmed their availability and the openness of the institutions they represent to follow closely the initiatives that will arise from the conference.

Dr. Faysel Alasmy, Dr. Paolo Saba for U.C.E.E. , and Dr. Patrizia Meoli for E.C.T, supported the initiative, by presenting some projects involving, apart from the various States, international Credit Institutions and major representatives of the world of enterprise and associations.

Some projects presented:

Food and Drug Agency

Creation, in cooperation with the government of Djibouti, of a professional agency to inspect and release all imported goods.

Hospital

Creation of the Djibuti General Hospital.

Cement Plant

Building of a cement plant, to meet the ever-growing needs of the markets of Ethiopia and Djibouti.

Paper mill

Creation of a paper mill, for the production of paper using recycled paper. Research of a partner.

Oil Refinery in Djibouti

Research of partners and financiers for the construction of a refinery in Djibouti.

Steel Plant

Possibility of agreements with partners and financiers for the construction of a steel plant in Ethiopia.

## Tantalum Mine

Possibility of agreements with partners and financiers for the construction of a mine in Ethiopia, to be built in an area rich in minerals.

The speeches by all the participants certainly paved the way to an effective cooperation.
